You will be passionate about providing information and resources to families with young children and must be able to work on a regular basis at events that are in communities located throughout Orange County at times that are convenient for families, such as late afternoon, evenings, and weekends.

You will be a strong leadership and organizational skills, as this position will help to design and coordinate a structure of people to work at events; and manage event logistics including event preparation and materials, staffing, and inventory. You will also lead in the physical organization of supplies for events.
